

Acacia fimbriata (Brisbane Wattle)

Classic SE Qld wattle with attractive feathery foliage, mainly in moister areas. Perfumed ball flowers to 8mm, winter to spring. Pods flattish, to 10cm x 8mm. Host plant to Tailed Emperor butterfly. Seed provides food for birds and feather-tailed gliders. Fast growing but somewhat short-lived.



Type: Shrub to 5m
