

Acacia juncifolia (Rush-leaved Wattle)

Tall, slender shrub in sandy soils. Phyllodes alternate, terete, to 20cm x 1mm, held erect. Ball flowers to 5mm, winter to spring. Terete pods to 10cm x 4mm constricted between seeds. Because the foliage is rather thin, the flowers are displayed to their best advantage.



Type: Shrub to 2m
Aspect: Part Shade
Soil: Sandy
Habitat: Dry Sclerophyll
