

## Acacia triptera (Spur-wing Wattle)

It is a rigid dry-country, twisted shrub, upright or low and spreading, 1-3 m high. Has long curving branches and stiff curved leaves which are very even and blue-green in a thriving plant. The entire plant is smooth and hairless. The bright yellow flowerheads appear from August to November, followed by curled or twisted brown seed pods which are 3 to 8 cm long and 2 to 4 mm wide.
