

Acronychia oblongifolia (White Aspen)

Tree often along watercourses. Leaves are opposite, hairless to 12cm and aromatic when crushed. White 4-petalled flowers in clusters in summer to autumn. Striking bright, white fruit produced during winter to 15mm. Berries taste like orange and are used in preserves.
