

Allocasuarina torulosa (Forest Oak)

Tree to 20m in fertile soils on mountains and hillslopes. Bark is rough and corky. Leaves reduced to 4 or 5 small teeth around stem. Branchlets pendant and reddening in winter. Cones are barrel-shaped, warty and 3cm long. A food source for Glossy Black Cockatoos.
