

Alogyne huegelii (Lilac Hibiscus)

Rapid growing, medium-sized shrub that likes well-drained soil. It is found naturally in sandy to sandy-gravel areas of South Australia and Western Australia. Tends to become a little sparse of foliage on lower limbs if left completely unpruned. After the main flowering flush in late spring the shrub can be pruned back quite hard. From late spring to the end of summer the species is covered in lilac flowers some 7 cm across with reddish-purple throats. excellent landscaping plant for drier climates.
