

Arytera divaricata (Coogera/Rose Tamarind)

An attractive plant with glossy pale and limp new leaves. It grows in fairly dry situations. Young shoots rusty brown. Leaves alternate, dark green, pinnate with up to 7 leaflets, each to 10cm. Tiny creamy-pink flowers in panicles throughout the year. 12mm yellow to brownish fruit, with red aril. Seeds mature June to October. Very hard timber.
