

## Auranticarpa rhombifolia (Diamond Leaf Pittosporum)

Grown in subtropical and dry rainforest areas. The creamy white flowers in dense clusters are mostly in summer but as early as spring and as late as March. Fruits are small, bright orange and pear-shaped, containing 2-3 black seeds. Leaves are toothed, glossy, green, ovate to rhomboid to 11cm. This tree is hardy and reliable, excellent as a garden subject and for planting in revegetation projects.
