

Austromyrtus dulcis (Midyim)

Good understorey plant. Sprawling shrub in coastal sandy soils. Leaves opposite to 30mm, discolourous and hairy below, aromatic when crushed. Traditional, favourite, native food. Beautiful foliage with bright pink tips. Profuse delicate, 5-petalled, white flowers in spring followed by delicious white, purple-speckled, sweet fruit to 10mm.
