

Austrosteenisia blackii (Blood Vine)

Tall, woody, vigorous climber with rusty-hairy young branches. When cut, stems have red sap. 5mm red flowers in spring then flat pods to 8cm x 20mm. Blooms resemble dark red peas and produce papery fruit up to 12cm long with kidney-shaped seeds.
