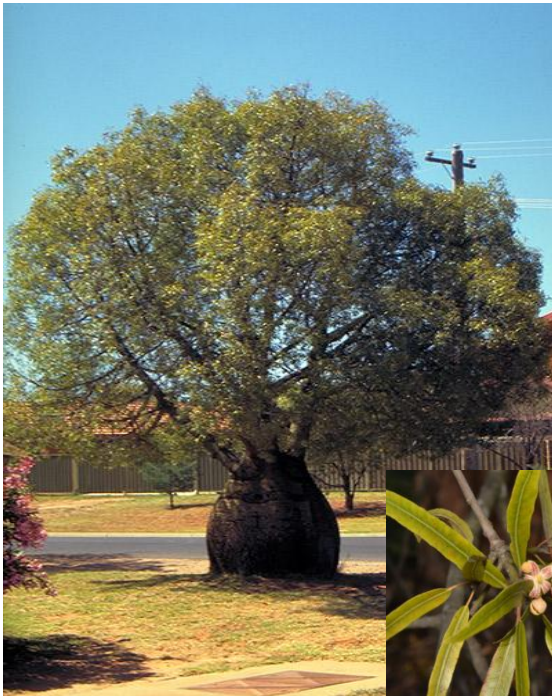


# Brachychiton rupestris (Narrow-leaved Bottle Tree)

Drought-deciduous, succulent tree of Central Queensland. Grows on tops and slopes of hills and ridges. Creamy-yellow bell-shaped flowers with red markings appear September to November. Each plant has distinct male and female flowers. Woody-boat shaped pods containing seeds appear from November to May.



**Type:** Tree to 15+m  
**Aspect:** Full Sun  
**Soil:** Well-drained  
**Habitat:** Dry Sclerophyll
