

Callerya megasperma (Native Wisteria)

Tall, woody vine of moister rainforests. Leaves alternate, compound, to 30cm, with 7-9 leaflets, each to 10cm long, with a terminal leaflet. 20mm purple flowers July to October. Velvety seed pod, longitudinally ribbed, to 18cm x 4 cm. Up to 4 seeds, to 4cm diameter. Very large and vigorous climber, forms canopy over surrounding vegetation. Beautiful but needs controlling. It often grows in association with the birdwing butterfly vine.
