

## Callitris baileyi (Bailey's Cypress)

Slender tree with green foliage. Leaves are green, 25 mm long, acutely keeled on dorsal surfaces. Cones are solitary on slender fruiting branchlets, glaucous during development; 10-13 mm in diameter, ovoid to oblong. Male and female cones occur on the same tree. Found in eucalypt woodland.
