

Capparis sarmentosa (Climbing Caper)

Prickly, scrambling, climbing vine in drier rainforests. Stems slender, zigzag. Paired spines to 2mm long at some leaf bases. Leaves alternate, to 20mm x 20mm. Fragrant white flowers to 25mm in spring. Oblong yellow to red, fleshy fruit to 25mm.



Type: Vine to 2m
Aspect: Full Sun/Part Shade
Soil: Well-drained
Habitat: Dry Sclerophyll
