

# Casuarina cunninghamiana (River She Oak)

Tree to 25m along creeks, rivers and on floodplains. Can form dense communities. Leaves scale-like around joints in green “needles” to 20cm long. Female flowers small, reddish. Brownish-cream male flowers in spikes at end of branchlets. Fruit 10mm woody “cones”. Attractive, hardy, fast growing tree, fine weeping foliage and dark grey bark. Useful drought fodder. Good for erosion control on banks
