

Clematicissus opaca (Pepper Vine)

This is a relatively small vine, with stems of 6 metres or less and thickness no more than 2cm. The leaves are palmate, with the central leaflets larger than the lateral. Leaf shape and size is highly variable. Leaf margins may be entire or toothed. Flowers to 5mm, in umbels, spring to autumn. Edible black fruit to 15mm.
