

Commersonia bartramia (Brown Currajong)

Tree, often of regrowth areas and watercourses. White, 5-petalled flowers to 5mm, in dense clusters in summer. Shoots densely hairy. It forms attractive lime green bristly fruit. Suitable for a large garden, it has a pyramidal shape with horizontal layered branches and is very ornamental when in flower and fruit. Egg-shaped, dull green leaves, whitish beneath with finely toothed margins. Fast growing.
