

Commersonia fraseri (Brush Kurrajong)

Uncommon, fast-growing tall shrub on rocky slopes and edge of rainforests. Alternate, softly hairy leaves to 15cm x 7.5cm, irregularly toothed. Whitish undersides. 10mm flowers in clusters towards the end of branches, in summer. Hairy fruits to 25mm across.
