

# Cordyline petiolaris (Broad-leaved Palm Lily)

Palm-like narrow, upright plant, often multi-trunked. Flowering occurs from late winter to spring, being white or lilac in colour. Fruit is a red berry, 7 to 10 mm in diameter. The fruit can persist on the plant for many months. Has long strap-like leaves to half a metre long.



**Type:** Shrub to 3m  
**Aspect:** Part Shade  
**Soil:** Moist  
**Habitat:** Wet Sclerophyll
