

Crinum pedunculatum (Swamp Lily)

Attractive perennial, with strap-like fleshy leaves to 1 m long and 10cm wide at base. Clumping plant along riverbanks. Large white scented flowers, with pink or purple filaments, on stems 1.5 m long from October to January. Big round pale green seeds, brownish when mature. Hardy, will grow in water and damp spots but is also drought & salt tolerant.
