

# Cryptocarya obovata (Pepperberry)

Rainforest tree whose trunk is straight and round in cross section, usually buttressed. The bark is grey or brown and usually fairly smooth. Cream flowers in panicles, February to May. Individual flowers about 3 mm long, almost without stalks. The fruit is a black globular drupe, usually ribbed, 12 mm in diameter, ripe March to May.
