

Cupaniopsis parvifolia (Small-leaved Tuckeroo)

A hardy, small tree with a spreading crown creating good shade. Cream flowers in branched panicles from upper leaf axils or terminal September to October. Fruit is a capsule, yellow, rough-skinned, 3-lobed, densely hairy inside, ripe November to January, with three seeds, blackish, surrounded by orange aril.
