

Derris involuta (Native Derris Vine)

Woody, vigorous, climbing vine, often along watercourses. Leaves alternate, compound, with 9-13 leaflets, each to 7cm x 35mm, dark and glabrous above, sparsely rusty-hairy below. White or purple pea flowers to 12mm in racemes, spring to summer. Flattened pods to 7cm x 12mm.
