

## Dianella revoluta (Blueberry Flax-lily)

An erect, hairless, perennial herb with a lifespan of many years, forming clumps and growing from rhizomes underground. The leaves are leathery, long and linear, varying in length from 1.5 – 8.5 cm and width from 4 – 15mm. Flowers spring to summer with deep blue to purple flowers. Fruit are blue to purple, 4-10mm round.
