

Dietes robinsoniana (Lord Howe Wedding Lily)

Only found naturally growing at Lord Howe Island. It does not tolerate cold temperatures. The leaves are sword-shaped or linear, 4 to 7 cm wide. Flowering occurs from September to December. The flowers are white with yellow, lasting for one day only. Flat triangular seeds form in a roundish shaped capsule, 3 to 4 cm long. The black seeds are around 10 mm long. Rare in cultivation.



Type: Lily to 1.5m
Aspect: Full Sun
Soil: Well-drained
Habitat: Forest margins/Coastal
