

Diospyros pentamera (Myrtle Ebony)

Tree with slightly zigzag branchlets. Leaves alternate, stiff, tapering to a fine point, dark above, grey-green with scattered deciduous fine hairs below. Fragrant, white bell-shaped flowers to 4mm in spring. Red fruit to 16mm long. The bark resembles ironbark trees.



Type: Tree to 15+m
Aspect: Full Sun/Part Shade
Soil: Moist, Fertile
Habitat: Wet Sclerophyll
