

# Ehretia acuminata (Koda)

Semi-deciduous tree often along watercourses. Leaves alternate, serrate, to 20cm long. Scented 5-petalled flowers to 4mm, in terminal panicles, spring. Globose yellow-orange fruit to 5mm in panicles, January to April, edible. *Ehretia acuminata* is a medium to large size tree and a 90 cm in trunk diameter. The bark is a creamy, grey, with vertical fissures. Koda is often easily identified in winter being deciduous and of the characteristic flutings at the base of the trunk.
