

Eucalyptus acmenoides (Yellow Stringybark)

Tree to 40m on sandy or stony soils. Bark rough, fibrous, usually shed on very small branches. Woody fruits to 6mm x 7mm. White flowers in early spring to summer. Timber used for poles, sleepers, bridge and wharf construction, stumps, plates, flooring, joists, weatherboards. Wood is resistant to termites.
