

Eucalyptus crucis (Silver Mallee)

A vulnerable tree which has a unique bark trait called "minni-ritchie" which is a rich, coppery red bark on the lower trunk. Rounded leaves of silvery-blue foliage shaped somewhat like a heart; Creamy yellow flowers appear in groups of seven, December to March, and the species has attractive gum-nuts.

Type: Tree to 6m
Aspect: Full Sun
Soil: Sandy Loam/Granite Outcrops
Habitat: Dry Sclerophyll
