

Eucalyptus exserta (Queensland Peppermint)

Tree to 25 m with grey, fibrous bark except on the upper branches. Leaves alternate, very narrow when young, increasing in size with age, aromatic when crushed. Grows on rocky, skeletal soils or silty sites. Woody toothed capsules to 7mm x 9mm.
