

Eupomatia laurina (Native Guava)

Handsome foliage plant. Requires pruning from early age to encourage branching and strengthen limbs. Attractive fast-growing plant; bright glossy foliage, perfumed cream/white flowers in summer. Green/yellow, cup-shaped, succulent edible berries in May to July. Good as understory plant.
