

Everistia vaccinifolia (Small-leaved Canthium)

Excellent ornamental plant. It is very hardy although slow growing. The branchlets are distinctly zigzagged and the intricate branching makes them feel almost spiny to the touch. Pale yellow or cream flowers with a reportedly unpleasant musty odour are borne in late summer to late autumn followed by small black fruits.
