

Hibiscus splendens (Splendid Hibiscus)

Very attractive shrub with rounded habit, velvety foliage. Also has prickles. Usually on fertile soils near the coast. Showy rose-pink flowers with red centres in spring to summer. Hairy seed capsules to 30mm long. Can be pruned. All parts of plant are Bush Tucker.
