

Hovea acutifolia (Purple Pea Bush)

Upright shrub to 2m, in open shady forest. Leaves alternate, to 7cm x 12mm, pubescent below. Masses of beautiful, blue to purple pea flowers, to 7mm, in spring. Pods to 15mm, sparsely hairy. Young pods are edible and pop audibly when ripe. Responds to pruning but not long lived.
