

## Hoya australis (Waxflower)

Succulent vine with twining stem usually on rock outcrops. Milky sap. Leaves opposite, thick to 15cm. Waxy, clusters of 10-20 5-petalled white flowers, each to 25mm, often with red markings. They have a strong sweet scent and produce abundant nectar. Tapering cylindrical seed pods to 15cm long. Flowers better if pot-bound.



**Type:** Vine to 5m  
**Aspect:** Full Sun/Part Shade  
**Soil:** Well-drained  
**Habitat:** Dry Sclerophyll
