

## Indigofera australis (Native Indigo)

A very common and widespread species. It grows in a variety of different habitats. Open spreading habit, blueish-green foliage, mauve-pink perfumed pea flowers in spring. The flowers are smooth, in short spires in the leaf axils. They may open at any time from mid-September and may continue till November in a cool spring. Can be pruned. Possibly toxic to cattle.



**Type:** Shrub to 1.5m  
**Aspect:** Full Sun/Shade  
**Soil:** Well-drained  
**Habitat:** Dry Sclerophyll
