

Kennedia rubicunda (Red Kennedy Pea)

Hardy, vigorous, scrambling vine. Reddish to orange flowers to 4cm, in racemes to 5cm in winter to spring. Pods densely hairy, to 10cm long. Good for embankments or trellis.

Type: Vine to 4m
Aspect: Full Sun/Part Shade
Soil: Well-drained
Habitat: Adaptable
