

Leptospermum brachyandrum (Weeping Tea-Tree)

Tall open shrub to 4m, usually with exposed trunks with flaky bark displaying colours of grey and soft pink. Flowers are small, white and occur in spring and early summer. Fruit capsules develop soon after the flowering season.



Type: Shrub to 4m
