

Leptospermum polygalifolium (Wild May)

Dense shrub to 3m, in open forest, wallum and along creek banks, with light green leaves and pendulous branches. Profuse white 5-petalled 10mm flowers in spring and summer are lovely in floral arrangements. Persistent, woody fruit to 10mm. Can be pruned. Leaves aromatic when crushed.
