

Livistona decora (Weeping Cabbage Palm)

Single-trunked, erect palm in wet coastal areas. Dense crown of leaves with drooping ends. Flower spikes to 2m in summer. A tall, solitary fan palm with leaves that have very pendulous segments. The petioles are armed with long spines, and the fruit to 1.5 cm wide are black. Long-lived and easy to grow.
