

Lomandra longifolia (Spiky Mat Rush)

Robust clumping plant to 1.3m, along watercourses, rainforest edges, on flood plains and in drier areas. Strap-like leaves stiff, to 1.3m long x 10mm, flat or slightly convex. Perfumed flowers on flattened spikes shorter than leaves, spring and summer. Separate male and female plants. Good for erosion control.



Type: Grass to 1.3m
Aspect: Full sun
