

Mallotus mollissimus (Soft Kamala)

Uncommon tree. New growth and leaf underside hairy. Leaves alternate, to 30cm. 2 raised glands at petiole apex. Hairy, 3-lobed 10mm fruit. Male and female yellowish flower spikes to 15cm, on separate plants. It is a typical regrowth species in coastal lowland and upland rain forest. Understorey tree.
