

## Maytenus bilocularis (Orangebark)

Small tree of drier rainforests with orange brown bark. Stiff leaves have toothed edges, hairless, to 9cm. Yellowish-green 5-petalled flowers in spring. Ovoid yellow fruit to 6mm, opening to two valves is ripe in March to August. Hardy plant but slow-growing.



**Type:** Tree to 12m  
**Aspect:** Part Shade  
**Soil:** Fertile  
**Habitat:** Dry Sclerophyll
