

Melaleuca incana (Grey Honey Myrtle)

Western Australia

Small shrub with a naturally dense frame of thin branches from the base. Cream to pale yellow brush-like flowers are up to 2.5 cm long, soft and graceful like the foliage. They open towards the end of October for three to four weeks. Leaves are narrow, 1.5 cm long, and like the young stems are covered with transparent hairs.

Type: Shrub to 2m
Aspect: Full Sun/Part Shade
Soil: Adaptable
Habitat: Dry Sclerophyll
