

## Melaleuca nodosa (Prickly Leaved Paperbark)

Shrub with papery, layered bark, drooping stems and linear, spiky leaves, in poorly drained soils. Masses of creamy-yellow flowers in 20mm heads in spring and summer. Woody fruit in 10mm clusters.
