Flowers are cream-yellow in June or September to December. Grows in white/grey, yellow or brown/red sand (often gravelly) and sandstone. Granite outcrops, undulating plains

Type: Shrub to 1m
Aspect: Full Sun
Soil: Well-drained
Habitat: Dry Sclerophyll
