

# Mentha diemenica (Native Mint)

Occurs in grassland and forest habitats. Grows vigorously and forms a dense ground cover 10-15 cm high. The dull green, opposite leaves are ovate to lanceolate and 4-12 cm long. Flowers are borne in the upper leaf axils from late spring to summer, usually mauve or lilac with four small petals.

**Aspect:** Full Sun/Part Shade  
**Soil:** Moist, well-drained  
**Habitat:** Dry Sclerophyll
