

Notelaea longifolia (Long-leaved Mock Olive)

Tall shrub or small tree usually in drier rainforests. Leaves opposite, stiff, leathery, to 15cm long, apex usually drawn out to a fine point. Veins prominent. Tiny, yellowish, 4-petaled flowers, winter to spring. Oblong, purplish-black fruit to 15mm long, spring to summer. Easily grown small tree that tolerates neglect.

Type: Tree to 9m
Aspect: Full Sun/Part Shade
Soil: Adaptable
Habitat: Dry Sclerophyll
