

Ozothamnus diosmifolius (Sago Flower)

Upright, branching, woody shrub which grows on stony clay and gravelly soils. Leaves aromatic when crushed are small, linear in shape to about 15 mm long. Flowers in dense heads to 10cm in spring to early summer, may be white or pink. Widely grown for the flower trade. Plants have short life – up to three years.



Type: Shrub to 2m
Aspect: Full Sun/Part Shade
Soil: Well-drained
Habitat: Dry Sclerophyll/
Heath
