

Pleiogynium timorense (Burdekin Plum)

This tree has a dense canopy with glossy dark green leaves and rough dark bark. The tree has yellowish-green flowers which flower between January and March and later grow into a fruit. These are globular deep-purple fruit to 5cm, edible when completely ripe but very sour otherwise, which makes an excellent jam. Hardy.
